

1. Population

The section contains statistical data on resident population size, women and men age composition, the number of births and deaths, including deaths by causes, migration flows, refugees and forced resettlers.

Information on births and deaths based on annual data processing of vital statistics provided by the Civil Acts of Registration Offices. Only number of live births are included in the number of births.

Data on **migration** flows received as a result of processing of arrival and departure statistics documents provided by local bodies of Ministry of the Interior and filled in at the places of residence in the course of registration.

Information on **refugees and forced resettlers** is compiled on the basis of data on the number of citizens of the Russian Federation and foreign citizens who took out the respective official status at territorial bodies of the Federal Migration Service and provided by the Federal Migration Service

Selected aggregate demographic indicators characterizing reproduction of population, life expectancy at birth, total fertility rate are presented in this section.

Persons at working age: women 16-54 years of age, men 16-59 years of age.

Life expectancy at birth – average number of years a newborn infant would live if prevailing patterns of mortality at the time of birth were to continue throughout the child's life.



Total fertility rate shows average number of children that would be born to each woman during her childbearing period (15-49) if fertility patterns of given period has not been changed and remained the same as it was in the year for which this indicator was calculated. Its value does not depend on age composition of population and characterize average fertility rate in the given calendar year.

Mortality rates by causes of death are compiled as a ratio of the number of death by a given cause to the mid-year population current assessment (per 100 000 persons of the respective sex).

These rates can depend on differences in the age composition of those dead.

Standardized mortality rates – age-directly standardized mortality rates, i.e. arithmetic average of indicators for 5-year age groups received for each groups of causes and weighted by unified age structure. European age structure standard is used for compilation.

Mortality rates at working age by main groups of causes – the number of deaths with given group of causes in working age divided by mid-year number of persons of the same age.

Maternal mortality – number of women deaths caused by complications during pregnancy and child birth per 100 000 live births.

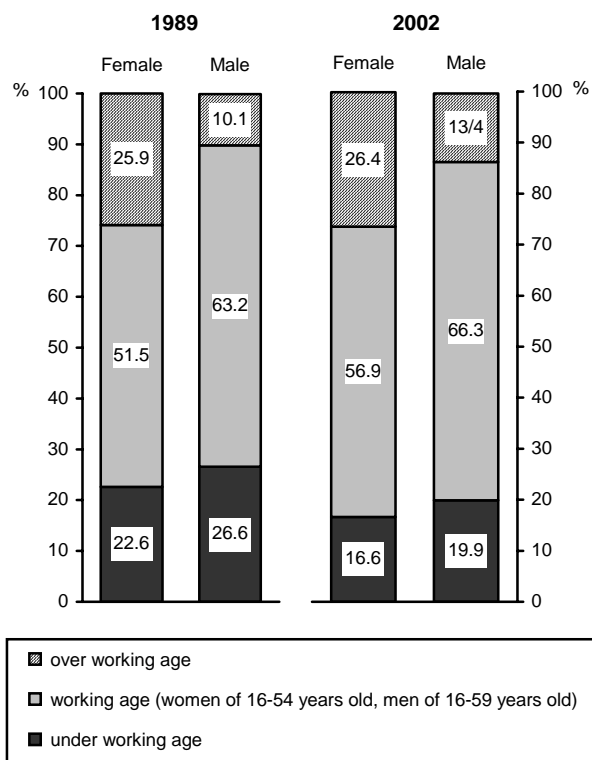

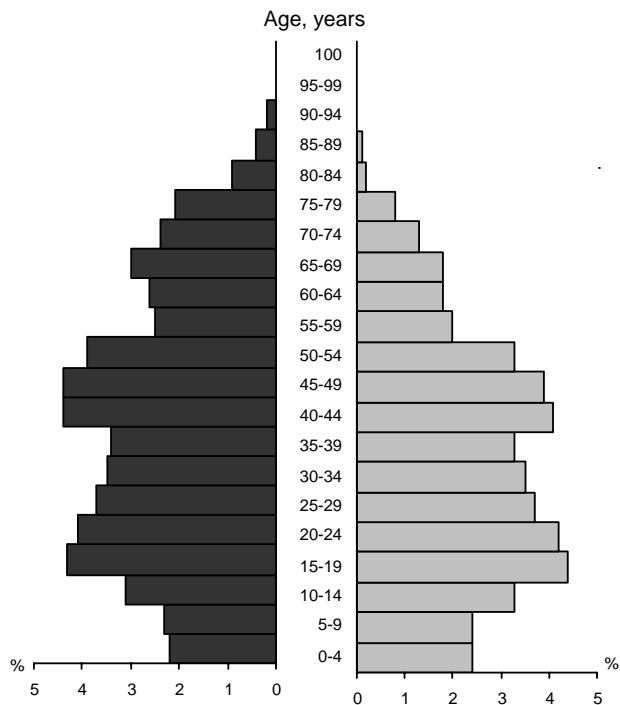
**1.4. Population by Age Groups

Share of female and male in total population size

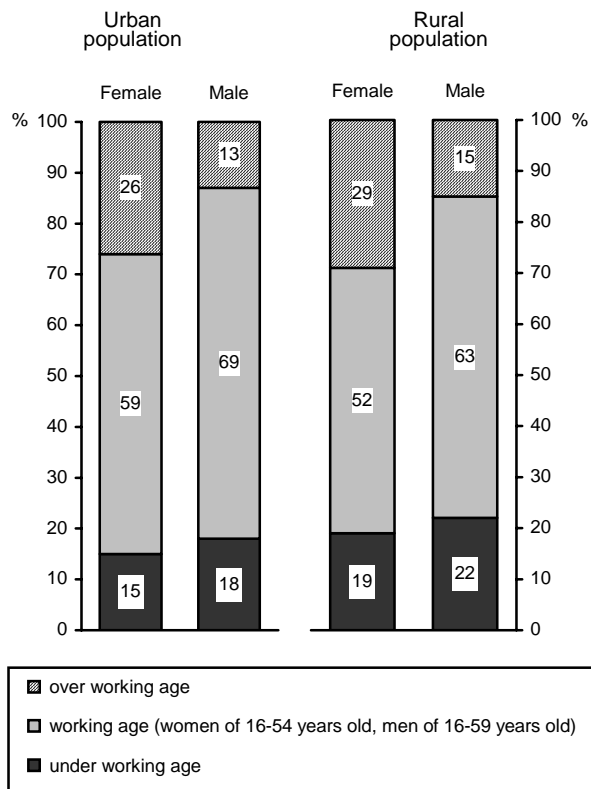
