

## 7. Offences

---

This section contains data on persons, including under-age, committed crimes and convicted for 1995-2003 as well as data on women and men convicted in 2003 by the type of crime.

**Recorded crime** - an exposed and officially registered a socially dangerous deed for which according to criminal legislation the corresponding responsibility is envisaged.

**Grave and especially grave crimes** referred to intentional and careless deeds for which the punishment is stipulated in accordance with the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation, items 4 and 5 article 15.

**The number of convicts** includes persons for whom courts have approved incriminatory sentences which have come into the legal force.

A person sentenced for a crime is considered convicted from the day when an incriminatory sentence have come into the legal force to the moment when a conviction is removed or cleared off.

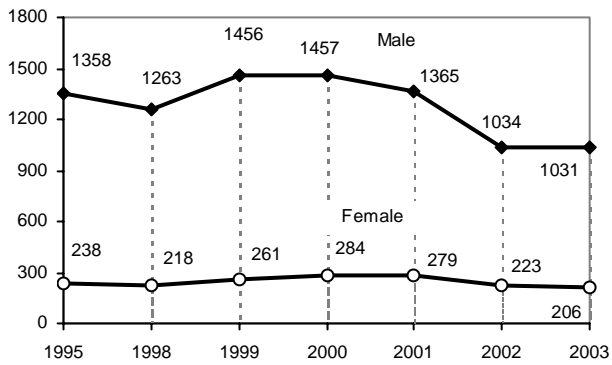


**Under age** persons are recognized those who by the time of the crime committed were of 14 years but under 18. In the Russian Federation the age for the criminal responsibility is 16 years and for some grave crimes persons of 14 years can be prosecuted to the criminal responsibility

Data of Ministry of the Interior, Ministry of Justice of Russia and Legal Department under the Supreme Court of the Russian Federation were used in this section.
